

Cloth masks do NOT replace: frequent hand washing and social distancing (6ft)



How to wear the cloth mask

Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds

Cloth mask should fully cover mouth and nose

Secure with ties or ear loops

Cover the cloth mask with beard net



How to remove the cloth mask

Remove the cloth mask from behind (do not touch the front of the cloth mask)

Wrap the cloth mask in a clean paper towel

Discard the gloves

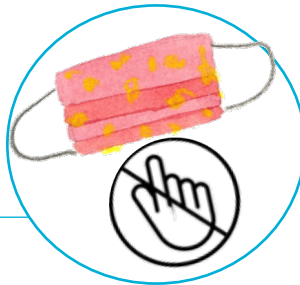
Wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds



How to care for the cloth mask

Avoid touching the cloth mask while wearing it; if you do, wash your hands for 20 seconds

When not in use or prior to eating, please wrap the cloth mask in a clean paper towel



How to clean the cloth mask

Cloth masks should be washed daily

Laundry in the washing machine with soap

Dry in the machine

Keep the cloth mask clean and sanitary to avoid mask becoming a source of contamination



Personal cloth masks must be treated like other GMP headwear and shall not have any type of inappropriate slogans/statements, stickers, pins or other form of potential physical contamination
